ORAL ORDER

This Court's previous order dated 20.02.2026
reads as under:

*"Sri.Mallikarjun N.K., the learned
counsel for the petitioner, submits that his
tentative instructions are that the respondents
are examining the possibility of withdrawing
the stipulation in condition No.8 in the tender
notification and therefore, the respondents
have not even opened the technical bids.*

*Sri B.Ravindranath, the learned Additional
Government Advocate, who is called upon to
accept notice for the respondents, shall secure
instructions in this regard and the office is
directed to re-list this petition on **25.02.2026.**"*

Sri B.Ravindranath, the learned Additional
Government Advocate, places on record the
Corrigendum dated 25.02.2026 and submits that the



condition impugned herein has been relaxed stipulating, amongst others, that there should be warrant for two years and during this warrant period successful bidder must attend to all the complaints within seven days.

In the light of the afore, the petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.
