ORAL ORDER

Sri Sagar D Naidu, the learned counsel for the petitioners, is heard on the petitioners' grievance with the alleged decision by the respondents to demolish standing structures in the petitioners' property for the purposes of road widening without due opportunity. The learned counsel submits that this decision is notwithstanding the orders of this Court that the properties cannot be demolished without due notice. The learned counsel relies upon the order of this Court dated 23.09.2021 in the writ petition in W.P. No.16568/2021.

In the light of the afore, the interim order is granted against demolition of the petitioners' properties to be in force until the next date of hearing.

Smt Saritha Kulkarni, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the respondents.
