ORAL ORDER

The petitioners have sought for issuance of writ of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to consider the representations of the petitioners dated 11.12.2025 at Annexures-E, F and G.

2. It is the case made out by the petitioners that though the land has been notified for acquisition, there has been no disbursal of compensation. Necessary representations for payment of compensation have been made at Annexures-E, F and G.

3. Sri. H.L. Pradeep Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - KIADB would submit that the said representations at Annexures-E, F and G would be considered and appropriate orders passed in accordance with law as per the legal entitlement of the petitioners within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.



4. Recording the undertaking of the learned counsel for the KIADB, petition is ***disposed of***. All contentions on merits are kept open. Needless to state, petitioners to make out clarifications and furnish the documents as may be required and the respondents are also at liberty to correspond with the revenue department, in the event any clarifications are required.
