ORAL ORDER

This Court's previous orders [*including the order dated 20.02.2026*], is perused. With the liberty being granted by this Court, Ms. Shilpa Shah, the learned Standing counsel for the second and third respondents, submits that the respondents have redesigned the structure to redress the petitioner's grievance, and the learned counsel also proposes to place on record such details to justify this stand.

This Court, at this stage, can only observe that the second and third respondents will have to bring the details on record to ascertain whether the petitioner's grievance is addressed. The respondents must be at liberty in this regard and they are reserved liberty, but there cannot be any precipitation. Hence, it is ordered that there shall be no

construction in front of the gate to the petitioner's property without the leave of this Court.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **02.03.2026.**
