ORAL ORDER

The petitioner, who is an opponent in the Consumer Complaint No.314/2025 on the file of the Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission,



Mangalore, Dakshina Kannada [*the District Forum*]
seeks relief that reads.

"Writ of Certiorari to quash the proceedings against the petitioner in Consumer Complaint No.314/2025, on the file of the learned Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Mangalore, D.K., filed by the respondent [Annexure - B] insofar as the petitioner is concerned."

Mr. Jithin Jeijo, the learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that this Court must intervene because a co-opponent in the proceedings has filed a memo accepting that he is responsible for the loss and that he will compensate the complainant; that a detailed enquiry is being conducted under the Karnataka Co-operative Societies Act, 1959 and that the police has also investigated into the same complaint.

This Court is of the considered opinion that all these circumstances can be placed before the District



Forum, and at this stage, there is no occasion for this Court to intervene. As such, the petition stands disposed of observing that all contentions are left open to be considered in the pending consumer proceedings.
