ORAL ORDER

Sri Rohith B J, the learned counsel for the petitioners, is heard on the petitioners' request for interim order. The petitioners' request is for directions to the second to fourth respondents to consider their representations, and these representations are filed to permit them to issue a Possession Certificate/remit the allotment price.

Sri Rohith B J, relying upon the tabular column that is part of the memorandum of the writ petition, submits that if some petitioners have paid the full price, the others have paid substantial sums and they are willing to pay the full amount but for reasons totally extraneous; but the petitioners are not permitted to pay the balance amount and secure the allotment letter.

Sri Rohith B J submits that the petitioners, who hail from marginalized sections, have been able to ascertain that there could be precipitation with cancellation and allotment of the corresponding house units as described in the Schedule appended to the writ petition.

In consideration of these submissions and on perusal of the records, the interim order is granted directing the respondents to maintain *status quo* without allotting the units mentioned in the schedule without the leave of this Court.

Sri. B Ravindranath, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the first respondent.

Sri N. Kumar, a learned standing counsel for the second to fourth respondents, are called upon to accept notice for these respondents.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **21.04.2026.**
