ORAL ORDER

1. The petitioners are before this Court seeking for the following reliefs:

- i. *Issue a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned notice bearing No. RO(KEN)W-198/JAN/2025-26/PRC-074039, dated 03.02.2026, issued by the 4th respondent vide Annexure-E;*
- ii. *Alternatively issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the 3rd respondents No.1 and 3 to consider the email representation dated 04.02.2026 and the representation dated 11.02.2026 vide Annexure-F and G.*



iii. Issue such other writ, order or direction as deems fit in the circumstances of the case and allow the above writ petition with costs, to meet the ends of justice and equity."

2. A memo dated 23.02.2026 has been filed signed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the same is taken on record.
3. Accepting the said memo and submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is ***dismissed as infructuous.***
