ORAL ORDER

The petitioner's grievance is with the rejection of his bid offered in response to the tender issued by Solid Waste Management. Ms. Sukanya H. D, the learned counsel for the petitioner, is heard and the learned counsel does not dispute that the petitioner has an alternative remedy under Section 16 of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements Act, 1999.

This Court must record that multiple petitions have been filed before this Court calling in question the decision to cancel the tenders which are disposed of with liberty to the concerned Court to pursue remedy. As such, the present petition also stands



disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy, and this Court must observe that this liberty is subject to all just exceptions in law.
