ORAL ORDER

Sri Harshavardhan, the learned counsel for the petitioner, is heard on the petitioner's grievance with the second respondent's floating Tender Notification dated 12.02.2026 inviting tenders for supply of *security manpower*, and the learned counsel is also heard on the petitioner's request for interim order.

Sri Harshavardhan submits that **[a]** the petitioner has been declared a '*successful bidder*' in the previous tender resulting in the contract dated 03.04.2025, **[b]** the agreement is subject to the condition that the petitioner's services shall be extended by a further period of one year **[c]** despite the representation the second respondent/its officers have issued the impugned notification on 12.02.2026 and the financial bids are scheduled to be opened on 28.02.2026, **[d]** in all probability, the petitioner would not be

extended the benefit of another year as contemplated under the agreement and **[e]** the respondents have issued Certificate of satisfaction.

In consideration of these submissions, the respondents are called upon to defer issuing work order pursuant to any finalisation of the bids that could be without the leave of this Court. The respondents will be at liberty to complete the pleadings and seek vacating.

Smt Saritha Kulkarni, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the first respondent.

Sri M Srinivas, a learned standing counsel for the other respondents, subject to entrustment otherwise, is called upon to accept notice for these respondents.

Sri Harshavardhan shall ensure copies of the petition papers are served on his chambers at the earliest.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **06.03.2026.**
