The petitioner filed this writ petition seeking mandamus directing respondent Nos.3 and 4 to consider the representations dated 30.09.2025 vide Annexures D and D1, wherein the petitioner requested respondent Nos.3 and 4 to release the RTE amount. The respondents have not passed any order on the representations submitted by the petitioner. Hence, this writ petition.

3. Learned Government Advocate submits that, if reasonable time is granted to respondent Nos.3 and 4, they would consider the representations vide Annexures D and D1, and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.
