ORAL ORDER

Sri J R Mohan, the learned counsel for the petitioners, seeks interim orders on the ground of parity relying upon the orders of this Court dated 26.02.2026 in the writ petition in W.P. No.6007/2026.

On perusal of records and this Court's afore order, the interim order in the following terms is granted.

[i] The petitioners in possession of shop premises in Block 'B' shall not be disturbed until the next date of hearing.

[ii] The petitioners, who occupy shops in Block 'A' shall be permitted to occupy those premises subject to further orders of this Court, but on the condition that they shall file an affidavit with the fourth respondent stating their willingness to take alternative

shops in terms of this Court's order dated
18.07.2025.

[iii] The fourth respondent is reserved with
liberty to move an application for vacating
the interim protection if these petitioners do
not file affidavit within the next two weeks.

Sri B Ravindranath, a learned Additional Government
Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the first and
second respondents.

Sri Nanda Kishore, a learned standing counsel for the
third and fourth respondents, is called upon to accept notice
for these respondents.

The office is directed to show the representation
accordingly and re-list this petition along with the writ
petitions in W.P. Nos.38807/2025 and 39132/2025 on
10.03.2026.
