1. Learned Additional Government Advocate has made submissions to the effect that an enquiry is required to be conducted in terms of the orders passed by this Court in Writ Petition No. 31431/2025. We have perused the same. Whilst there may be other proceedings pending in regard to the subject land, the order dated 30.09.2024 is unequivocal inasmuch as it directs the Tahsildar to immediately proceed with the mutation of the petitioner's name in the record of rights in compliance with the directions issued in Writ Petition No. 1504/2022. According to the learned Additional Government Advocate, there are rival claims as to the subject land. However, those would necessarily have to be considered in appropriate proceedings. Insofar as the present proceedings are concerned, the scope is limited to examining whether there

is a willful disobedience of the orders passed by this Court. We note that the learned Single Judge has also passed orders in Writ Petition No. 31431/2025, observing that there have been repeated failures on the part of the accused to comply with the order passed by this Court. These observations are required to be taken seriously. At this stage, the learned Additional Government Advocate requests for further time of one week.
