THIS W.P. IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 & 227 OF CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PRAYING TO ISSUE A WRIT OF MANDAMUS, DIRECTING THE RESPONDENTS TO IMPLEMENT THE DATE OF BIRTH OF THE PETITIONER AS DT.10.03.1968 IN PLACE OF DT.10.03.1966 IN THE SERVICE RECORDS OF THE PETITIONER WORKING AS LIBRARIAN SUPERVISOR AS PER HIS ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE VIDE AT ANNEXURE-A AND B AND ETC.,

THIS PETITION, COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY HEARING, THIS DAY, ORDER WAS MADE THEREIN AS UNDER:

ORAL ORDER

In this petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

- "a. To issue a **WRIT OF MANDAMUS**, directing the Respondents to implement the date of birth of the Petitioner as dt.10.03.1968 in the Service Records of the Petitioner working as Librarian Supervisor as per his original Birth Certificate vide at **ANNEXURE-'A' & 'B'**.*
- b. To issue a **WRIT OF MANDAMUS**, directing the Respondents to extend the service of the Petitioner from dt.10.03.2026 to dt.10.03.2028 along with Emoluments and promotions, based on the Service Record of the Petitioner vide at **ANNEXURE-'B'**.*
- c. To issue any other writ or direction/s that, this Hon'ble Court deems fit to grant in the circumstances of the case, with costs, in the interest of justice and equity."*

2. After arguing the matter for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition may be disposed of reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to submit a fresh/new



representation along with all relevant documents to the respondents, who may be directed to consider the same, within a stipulated timeframe and proceed further, in accordance with law.

3. The said submission is placed on record.

4. The petition stands disposed of reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to submit a fresh/new representation along with all the relevant documents ventilating his grievances. If such a representation along with relevant documents is submitted by the petitioner to the respondents, within a period of four weeks from today, the concerned respondents shall consider the same and take appropriate decision/pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of submission of such representation and documents by the petitioner.

5. Subject to the aforesaid directions and reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner, petition stands disposed of.
