ORAL ORDER

Both Sri A Mahesh Chowdhary, the learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri Nishanth A V, learned counsel for the first respondent, submit that the petitioner's grievance would be addressed if the second respondent at whose instance the petitioner is issued with a contract makes over requisite funds for payment. In fact, Sri Nishanth A V submits that the first respondent has communicated with the second respondent and instructions on payment are awaited.

Smt Saritha Kulkarni, a learned Additional Government Advocate, submits that if at all any amount can be claimed, it has to be from the second respondent because there is no contract between the first and the second respondents.

In the light of the afore, Sri Nishanth A V is called upon to place on record the documents based upon which contract is issued to the petitioner and it is submitted that the amount must be paid by the second respondent.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **25.02.2026** in the *orders* category.
