ORAL ORDER

In this petition, petitioner seeks for the following reliefs:-

- “a) Issue a Writ of mandamus directing the Respondents to transfer the Petitioner to his Home Zone as per Circular No.07/2024 (Annexure-A) and as per their undertaking by way of a written communication dated 31.05.2025, bearing No.E-38014/ANNUAL TRANSFER – 2025/STA-II/1543, vide Annexure – D.*
- b) Pass such other order or orders as this Hon’ble Court deems fit to grant under the facts and circumstances of the case, including costs of the proceedings, in the interest of justice and equity.”*

2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 4 has filed a memo enclosing a copy of the communication dated 15.01.2026, whereby the request of the petitioner for transfer has been rejected.

3. Memo and communication are placed on record.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition and file a fresh petition seeking appropriate reliefs including challenging the said communication.
