ORAL ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed a
memo. Memo reads as under:

"The petitioner submit that petitioner is agreed to pay the cheque amount Rs 450000/- to the respondent/complainant, the petitioner has already 118750/- as 25% deposit in appellate court, the said amount was released by this hon'ble court to the respondent/ complaint and remaining balance amount Rs 331250/- is agreed to paid in following in the seven installments in every month on or before 21-04-2026 to 21-10-2026 is agreed to be paid 50,000/- in every month till 21-09-2026 and remaining amount of Rs 31250/-is agreed to paid on 21-10-2026. The above terms of the memo, the matter may be disposed. the Memo may be taken on record and pass necessary order, in the interest of Justice and equity".



2. Counsel for the respondent has endorsed no objection.

3. Placing the memo on record, petition stand ***disposed off.***

4. Amount in deposit if any, is ordered to be withdrawn by the complainant under due identification.

5. It is made clear that if there is any default in the payment of compensation amount, then the petitioner shall undergo imprisonment as ordered by the Trial Magistrate confirmed by the First Appellate Court.
