ORAL ORDER

After addressing the arguments for some time, learned counsel for the revision petitioner files a memo which reads as under:

"It is submitted that the petitioner has been convicted sentenced to pay fine of Rs.6,75,000/- for offence u/S 138 of NI Act. As per instructions of the petitioner he has already deposited 50% of the cheque amount before the Hon'ble Trial Court and he is ready to pay the remaining amount of Rs.4,50,000/- in five installments from 15th of April 2026 to the respondent at Rs.90,000/- pm from April 15th of 2016 to 15th Aug, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner most respectfully prays that this Hon'ble Court be pleased to take this Memo on record and dispose of the above petition, in the interest of justice."

2. Placing the memo on record, revision petition stands ***disposed of.***



3. The amount in deposit is ordered to be withdrawn by the complainant.

4. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid as agreed in the memo and if there is default in payment of single installment, accused shall undergo imprisonment as ordered by the Trial Magistrate confirmed by the First Appellate Court.
