ORAL ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, the petitioner will not press prayer (b). The submission is placed on record.

2. The petitioner filed this writ petition seeking a mandamus directing respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 06.04.2024 submitted by the petitioner vide Annexure-A, wherein the petitioner has stated that, respondent No.4-Society has allotted sites overlooking the seniority and also that there is misappropriation to the tune of Rs.8,00,00,000/- and requested respondent No.3 to issue a direction to the Auditor to incorporate the defects pointed out in the representation.

3. Respondent No.3 has not passed any order on the representation submitted by the petitioner. Hence, this petition.



4. Learned AGA for respondent Nos.1 to 3 submits that, if reasonable time is granted, respondent No.3 will consider the representation vide Annexure-A and would pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned AGA, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** directing respondent No.3 to consider the representation vide Annexure-A and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law, within 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. In view of disposal of the petition, pending IA(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
