ORAL JUDGMENT

(PER: HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE JAYANT BANERJI)

Against the order dated 21.12.2023 passed in M.C No.31/2021 whereby, the Trial Court allowed the petition filed by the wife and the counter claim made by the husband under Section 13(1)(ia) and Section 23(A) of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage, both the wife and the husband filed the aforesaid appeals respectively. The matter was referred for mediation.

2. A memorandum of settlement has been filed. As per the memorandum of settlement, the dispute with regard to permanent alimony has been fully and finally settled between the parties with a total sum of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs Only) having been acknowledged and paid. The parties have agreed to withdraw pending M.F.As. and that all cases filed by both of them shall stand dismissed/disposed of.



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3. In view of the aforesaid settlement, both these appeals stand disposed of, that is to say the decree of divorce is upheld and with regard to the other disputes, the parties shall be bound by the memorandum of settlement. The memorandum of settlement shall therefore form part of the decree. This order has been passed in the presence of the parties who have been identified by their respective advocates.
