ORAL ORDER

The present petition is filed for quashing the Communication which is dated 28.03.2025 [*Annexure-F*]. Sri. Rajesh S.V., the learned counsel for the second and the third respondents who have caused the subject tender, submits that:

[a] the impugned Communication is addressed to the petitioner to complete



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the transaction based on the offer made
in response to the tender;

[b] the petitioner has not come forward to
pay Rs.90 Crores as offered in the bid
stating that she intended to offer only
Rs.9 Crores but by an inadvertent error
she offered a sum of Rs.90 Crores.

Crucially, the learned counsel submits that
the tender in which the petitioner has participated is
recalled and a fresh tender is issued with an award
in favour of a third party. These circumstances
persuade this Court to accept that the petition is
rendered infructuous and the petition stands
disposed of accordingly.
