ORAL ORDER

Sri H.C. Shivaramu, the learned Counsel for the petitioner, arguing for correction [*as requested for in the application in I.A. No.1/2026*], submits that this Court by an error has mentioned the year of the concerned Order as '1992' instead of '2016', and that taking advantage of the same, respondent No.2 has orally informed the petitioner that the request for transfer of authorization will not be considered.

Sri G.A. Guruswamy, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is heard in the light of the afore.

This Court must now provide for correction of the Order dated 27.01.2026 as it is only a typographical error. Therefore, the Office is directed to correct the year 1992 as

2016 and issue fresh certified copies. The application in I.A. No.1/2026 is disposed of accordingly.

Further, the Court must observe that this Court are not rendered ineffective on technical grounds, and hence, respondent No.2 must be directed to ensure that the authorization is transferred immediately on receipt of a copy of this order and the corrected orders are furnished.

It is ordered accordingly directing respondent No.2 to file a report with the Registry on due compliance within a week from the receipt of orders as aforesaid.
