ORAL ORDER

1. None appears for the petitioners despite the matter being called out twice. This Court had on 31.01.2026 had passed the following order:

"1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners sought for an adjournment.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents points out that petitioner No.1 has died in the year 2021. However, no appropriate steps have been taken by the learned counsel for the petitioners to amend the cause title.

3. A finally, an opportunity is granted to the petitioners to do the needful, failing which the petition shall be dismissed for non-prosecution.

4. List this petition on 23.02.2026.

5. Interim order granted earlier is extended till the next date of hearing.

6. Released from part-heard."

2. As stated, final opportunity was granted to the petitioners to take appropriate steps. The report of the



Registry is that no steps were taken by the petitioners despite repeated opportunities.
