ORAL ORDER

Both Mr. Prashanth S. Shivadass, the learned counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. Aravind V. Chavan, a learned Standing Counsel for the respondents, submit that **[a]** different petitions have been filed on the same cause of action, **[b]** the interim orders have been granted by the Co-ordinate Benches in these matters, **[c]** the details of pending writ petitions and the copies of the interim orders are part of compilation filed on 08.06.2026, and **[d]** a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is hearing these matters and that this Court could direct tagging all these matters for common adjudication while granting stay as prayed for but with liberty to the respondents to oppose the same once the pleadings are complete.

In the light of these submissions and on perusal of the records, the interim order is granted as prayed for to be in

force until further orders. The respondents are reserved with liberty as aforesaid.
