ORAL ORDER

Cash in a sum of Rs.15,000/- is tendered by the revision petitioner to the learned counsel for the respondent. Same is acknowledged by signing the order sheet.

2. A memo is filed for payment of the balance amount, which reads as under:

"The counsel for petitioner herein paid a sum of Rs.50,000/- on 16.03.2026 and on Rs.23.03.2026 Rs.15,000/- paid in cash and settled for Rs.1,40,000/-, balance Rs.1,40,000/- will be paid in two installments of Rs.70,000/- on 20.04.2026 and final amount on Rs.70,000/- on or before 20.05.2026. The same may be recorded in the interest of justice and equity."

3. Placing the memo on record, revision petition stands ***disposed of.***

4. The amount in deposit is ordered to be withdrawn by the complainant under due identification.



5. It is made clear that if the amount is not deposited as stated in the memo, revision petitioner shall undergo imprisonment as ordered by the Trial Court confirmed by the First Appellate Court.
