This appeal has been filed by the wife seeking to challenge the judgment and decree dated 08.12.2021 passed by the 6th Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Bengaluru, in MC No. 833/2016.

By means of the decree, the petition filed by the appellant under Section 13(1)(i-a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was dismissed and the counter-claim filed by the husband under Section 23A read with Section 13(1)(i-a) and (i-b) of the said Act was allowed.
