ORAL JUDGMENT

The present intra Court appeal has been filed impugning the judgment and order dated 22.01.2015 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P.No.36808/2015 (LB-BMP) filed by appellants herein.

2. The impugned order reads as under :-

"Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing the matter for some time seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition reserving liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum in respect of his entitlement over the property.

2. Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn reserving to the petitioners to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum in respect of his entitlement over the property in question. It is needless to state in the event the petitioners succeeds in the suit, they are also at liberty to revive their claim that the structure that has come up is illegal and would require demolition, as conceded by the Corporation."



3. In view of the above, we ***dismiss*** this writ appeal.

4. In view dismissal of the appeal, pending interim applications, if any do not survive for consideration, hence stand disposed of.
