ORAL JUDGMENT

Aggrieved by the award passed in MVC No.2218/2016 dated 25.03.2017 passed by the XXI A.C.M.M and XXIII A.S.C.J and member, MACT, Bengaluru, the appellant/Insurance Company is before this Court seeking to set aside the aforesaid award.

2. The matter was referred to the Mediation and the same was settled between the parties, whereby the claimants have agreed for compensation of an amount of Rs.11,00,000/- inclusive of interest.

3. The Insurance Company has already deposited a sum of Rs.5,40,614/- on 13.07.2017 and the remaining amount of Rs.5,34,386/-, they will deposit the same before the Tribunal within six weeks from the date of acceptance of the agreement by this Court.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant/ Insurance Company submits that remaining amount shall be deposited within two weeks from today.



5. Accordingly, in the light of the settlement arrived at between the parties dated 25.03.2026, the appeal is ***disposed of.***

- i. The Respondent is at liberty to withdraw the amount deposited by the Insurance Company before this Court.
- ii. Pending IAs., if any, shall stand closed.
