Heard the proxy counsel Sri. Neladurga S. Vijaykumar, appearing on behalf of the learned counsel for the complainant.

2. Willful disobedience of the order dated 21.04.2025 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.8120/2025 is alleged.

3. It appears that an order dated 10.01.2025 was passed by the trial Court in a petition filed under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 granting visitation rights. This order was subjected to challenge in the aforesaid writ petition. A direction was passed by the Writ Court regarding visitation rights. Allegation is that those directions have not been complied with.

4. It is the admitted case of the complainant that the proceedings in the petition under the Guardians and Wards Act in G&WC No.131/2018 have concluded with passing of a judgment on 14.07.2026.

5. It is stated by the learned counsel that the provisions of the Code of Civil Procedure are applicable in such cases before the Family Court. Section 18 of the Family Courts Act provides for the procedure for execution of decrees and orders. The procedure would govern any order passed in appeal, which proceedings would be nothing but an extension of the proceedings before the Family Court. Moreover, since the proceedings in the G&WC case have concluded with passing of the judgment, it is for the aggrieved party to avail of such remedy as may be advised. This contempt petition is consigned.
