ORAL ORDER

When queried, Ms Saritha A L, the learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the second and third respondents are authorities from National Highway Authority of India, and she may be permitted to make necessary corrections in the cause title. The learned counsel is permitted.

As regards the interim order, this Court is of the considered view that the learned counsel for the petitioner must be reserved with liberty to seek interim orders on the next date of hearing and there must be orders to the standing counsels to take notice for the respective respondents with Mr Kenchegowda, a learned Additional Government Advocate, taking notice for the first respondent.

Ms. Shilpa Shah, a learned standing counsel for the second and third respondents, is called upon to accept

notice for these respondents. Mr. M S Devaraju, a learned standing counsel for the fourth respondent, is called upon to accept notice for this respondent.
