ORAL ORDER

1. Learned AGA accepts notice for respondents No.1 to 4.
2. The petitioner is the cousin brother of Sri.Umesha, S/o late Mallaiah (CTP No.10958), who is currently serving sentence in Central Prison.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that premature release of detainee has been approved by the Advisory Committee, however, today morning the mother of the detainee has expired. In that view of the matter, the respondent No.4-the Chief Superintendent, Central Prison, Bengaluru, is directed to release Sri.Umesha, S/o late Mallaiah (CTP No.10958) on emergency parole for a period of 15 days commencing from 5.06.2026, subject to the following conditions.

- a) The prisoner (CTP No.10958) shall mark his attendance in the jurisdictional Police Station, weekly once throughout the period of his parole and it would be the responsibility of the jurisdictional Police to take him to gaol, in the event, the convict (CTP No.10958) would evade going back to the gaol, after the expiry of the period of emergency parole.
- b) Respondent No.1 shall stipulate strict conditions as are usually stipulated to ensure return of the detenu to the gaol and that he shall not commit any other offence during the period of parole.
4. The Registry is directed to communicate the order to the prison Authority for its immediate execution.
5. Learned AGA is also directed to communicate the concerned.
6. Relist on **15.06.2026**.
7. Hand delivery ordered.
