ORAL ORDER

The petitioners are before this Court calling in question the registration of a private criminal complaint in PCR No.58336/2024 on the file of the XXIX Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall, Bengaluru.

2. During the subsistence of the subject petition, the parties to the *lis* have entered into a settlement and filed a joint affidavit to that effect.

3. The joint affidavit reads as follows:-

"JOINT AFFIDAVIT

We, the authorized representatives of the Petitioners, Charan Raj S/o.Vasantha M, aged about 38 years, having our registered office at UNIT 803, Lodha Supremus, Saki Vihar Road, Opp MTNL. Office, Powai, Mumbai 400072, and today at Bangalore and the Respondent No.2, Lakshamma, D/o Munianjinaappa, aged about 52 years, residing at No.145, Near Gangamma Temple, Kariyanapalya,



near Hennur main Road, Bangalore-560084, do hereby affirm and state on oath as under:

- 1. We, the Petitioners and Respondent No.2, are deposing to this affidavit today in the above-said case and we are well aware of the facts and circumstances of the case, and we are competent to swear to this affidavit.*
- 2. We state that the averments made in the Memorandum of Petition may be treated as part and parcel of this affidavit in order to avoid brevity.*
- 3. We state that the Petitioners have filed the above petition with a prayer to quash (i) entire Private Criminal Complaint dated May 27, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 in so far as the Petitioners are concerned in PCR No.58336/2024 for offences p/u/s Section 465, 471, 120B read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code against the Petitioners herein arrayed as accused no.1 to 7 filed and pending before the XXIX Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall Bangalore and (ii) Order dated June 28, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 and the proceedings thereon in so far as the Petitioners are concerned in PCR No.58336/2024 passed by the XXIX*



Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall Bangalore.

- 4. We state that, we are willing to settle/compound the offences, and the Respondent No.2/Complainant shall withdraw the allegation against all the Petitioners. Subsequently, to facilitate the said settlement the Petitioners and Respondent No.2 have amicably settled the dispute out of court on the advice of well-wishers. The Respondent No.2/Complainant is not ready and willing to proceed with the case against the Accused persons/Petitioners.*
- 5. We state that thereby we mutually agree that we have no claims, differences or enmity against each other.*
- 6. We state that we both have settled all our differences and have decided close the dispute in a dignified manner without any friction or dispute between us and have opted for the final settlement lawfully.*
- 7. We state that there is no coercion, fraud, undue influence or force from anybody upon us to file this affidavit and the Respondent No.2/Complainant willfully has given consent*



to quash the quash the entire Private Criminal Complaint dated May 27, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 in so far as the Petitioners are concerned in PCR No.58336/2024 for offences p/u/s Section 465, 471, 120B read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code against the Petitioners herein arrayed as accused no.1 to 7 and the reference dated June 28, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 and the proceedings thereon filed and pending before the XXIX Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall Bangalore, against the Petitioners/Accused persons which was initiated by the Respondent No.2, which is the subject matter of this Criminal Petition.

WHEREFORE, *we humbly pray that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to accept the joint affidavit and to allow the Interlocutory Application for compounding/settlement of the offences and allow the above-mentioned Criminal Petition to quash the entire Private Criminal Complaint dated May 27, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 in so far as the Petitioners are concerned in PCR No.58336/2024 for offences p/u/s Section 465, 471, 120B read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code against the Petitioners herein arrayed as accused no.1 to 7 and*



the reference order dated June 28, 2024 in PCR No.58336/2024 and the proceedings thereon filed and pending before the XXIX Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall Bangalore in so far as the Petitioners herein are concerned."

4. The joint affidavit also recognizes the closure of the present proceedings. In the light of the joint affidavit, the proceedings against the petitioners are to be obliterated.

5. Hence, the following order is passed:

ORDER

- (i) The petition stands disposed in terms of the joint affidavit.
- (ii) The proceedings in PCR No.58336/2024 pending on the file of the XXIX Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Mayo Hall, Bengaluru, for the offences punishable under Sections 465, 471, 120B read with Section 149 of IPC, are quashed *qua* the petitioners.



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- (iii) In view of disposal of the petition, pending
I.As., if any, do not survive for
consideration and the same stand disposed.
