The present writ petition is filed seeking the following prayer:

"PRAYER:

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to;

i) issue writ of mandamus directing respondent No.2 police to submit the report to the Jurisdictional Magistrate pursuant to the registration of the FIR in Crime No.15/2021 for an offence punishable U/S 420, 504, 506 R/W Section 34 of IPC vide Annexure-A,

ii) issue any appropriate writ, order or direction directing the respondent No.2 not to confine the petitioner in the police station for unreasonable period without any justification,"

2. Learned High Court Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submits that the Police have filed the charge sheet and the same is numbered as C.C.No.3103/2023 on the file of the 41st Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Bengaluru. In the light of the same, nothing survives for



consideration in this petition. Hence, this Court is passing the following:
