ORAL ORDER

Petitioner is before this Court being aggrieved by the inaction on the part respondent-Authorities in regularizing his sanitary and water connections to the premises bearing No.58, 7th Cross, Babusapalya, Chalakere Village, Bengaluru.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount as demanded by the respondent-BWSSB in terms of Annexure-A dated 22.05.2013 aggregating to sum of Rs.8,68,780/- is already been paid. That despite payment of said amount, respondent-BWSSB have not regularized the same.



3. Learned counsel for the respondent Nos.2 to 4 on the other hand submits that if the petitioner furnishes the required documents with regard to constructions and its legality, his request would be considered in accordance with law.

4. Submission is taken on record.

5. Petition is ***disposed of.***

6. Petitioner to make fresh representation along with necessary documents, as may be requisitioned by the respondent-BWSSB for processing the request in accordance with law. On submission of the same. Respondent-BWSSB after affording sufficient opportunity to petitioner, pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within sixty days thereafter.

7. No precipitative actions shall be taken till disposal of the said representation.
