ORAL JUDGMENT

In CCC No.755/2024:

Learned counsel appearing for the complainants has filed a memo seeking leave of the Court to withdraw the contempt petition.

2. Memo is placed on record.



3. In view of the memo, contempt petition is ***dismissed*** as ***withdrawn***.

In CCC No.1387/2024:

This contempt petition is filed alleging willful disobedience of the order of the learned Single Judge dated 13.07.2022, passed in W.P. No.11567/2022.

2. The operative portion of the order reads as under;

"a) Writ petition is disposed of.

b) Respondent No.3 is directed to consider the representation dated 07.05.2022 at Annexure-H and second representation dated 21.05.2022 at Annexure-J within a period of 4 weeks' from today strictly in accordance with law as per the available documents.

c) Respondent No.4 is also permitted to participate in the said proceedings and submit such documents to the respondent No.4 to enable the respondent No.3 to pass necessary orders.

d) Respondents to act on a print out of the uploaded copy of this order on the website of this



Court, if so furnished by the petitioner, without waiting for certified copy thereof. If respondents have any doubt about the order, respondents may verify the contents of the order from the website of this Court and or from the learned panel advocate appearing in the matter. The OR code on this order could also be scanned to view the website of the High Court to verify the order."

3. Learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the respondent- State has filed a compliance affidavit of respondent No.1- the Special Land Acquisition Officer, V.V. Towers, Bengaluru Urban District. Para No.5 of the said affidavit reads as under;

"In compliance with the orders of this Hon'ble Court in the above two writ petitions, notices were issued to the Petitioners and Respondent No.3 in Writ Petition No. 11567/2022 to appear before this office and produce documents. Both parties were heard, and upon consideration of the records and submissions, an order dated 06.08.2025 was passed. The copy of the Order dated 06.08.2025 is produced herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-R1. An intimation letter dated 22.08.2025, enclosing the said order, was issued to the Petitioners and



Respondent No.3. The copy of the same is produced herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-R2. The directions of this Hon'ble Court have thus been duly complied with."

4. The affidavit is enclosed along with the order passed by the Land Acquisition Officer. In view of the said affidavit and the order, we are of the opinion that there is compliance of the direction issued by the learned Single Judge. Accordingly, the contempt proceedings are **closed**. Notice issued to the accused shall stand discharged. It is open for the complainants to work out their remedies in accordance with law.
