ORAL ORDER

On perusal of records and upon hearing Mr. K. R. Ramesh, the learned counsel for the petitioners who alleges that the use and occupation of the panchayath road abutting their lands is being disturbed by the private respondents, Mr. A. Nagarajappa, a learned Standing counsel for the concerned Zilla Gram Panchayath and the Chief Executive Officer - the second to fourth respondents, is called upon to accept notice for these respondents.

Mr. Kenche Gowda, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the first respondent.

Mr. K. R. Ramesh shall ensure copies of the petition/annexures are served on the chambers of Mr. A. Nagarajappa at the earliest.

There shall be notice by hand returnable by
06.07.2026 to the private respondents.

It is observed that any construction in the portion as indicated in Annexure - C by the private respondents or the other respondents shall be subject to further orders of this Court.
