ORAL ORDER

(PER: HON'BLE MR. VIBHU BAKHRU, CHIEF JUSTICE)

1. The learned counsel appearing for the accused in CCC No.845/2025 once again seeks an adjournment on the ground that a Special Leave Petition (Civil) has been preferred against the order dated 16.12.2025 of the Division Bench of this Court dismissing the appeals (W.A.No.711/2024 and connected matters), which are preferred against the common order dated 07.03.2024 passed in W.P.No.10632/2021 and connected matters, the disobedience of which is alleged.

2. This Court had acceded to similar request and on 17.04.2026 deferred the hearing of the present petition for a further period of six weeks.

3. It does appear that the accused is unwilling to comply with the order passed by the court. However, acceding to the

request, we defer the present proceedings for the further period of six weeks from date. We clarify that in the event, the accused has not complied with the order, the disobedience of which is alleged and there is no order varying or vacating the directions issued, the accused shall be present before this Court on the next date of hearing for framing of charges.
