ORAL ORDER

This Court has issued witness summons to Sri J.R.Bhaskar, a witness cited by the petitioner to tender evidence with the learned counsel for the petitioner furnishing requisites for issuance of such summons. The office has also issued the summons which is returned '*unclaimed*'.

In the circumstances and in view of the provisions of Rule 25 of the Election Petitions Procedure Rules, Karnataka, 1967 read with Order XVI Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, bailable warrant for Rs.50,000/- [Rupees Fifty Thousand only] is issued to Sri J.R. Bhaskar to be executed by the Jurisdictional Police, Srirangapatna, Mandya District. The warrant shall be executed before the

next date of hearing, and the office is directed to relist this petition on 12.02.2026.

The witness, PW.1, who is present in Court is bound over until the next date of hearing for Further Cross-examination in the light of this Court's previous order.
