**ORAL ORDER**

Sri Mohit U. Thodaskar, the learned counsel for the petitioner, is heard on the petitioner's grievance and request. The petitioner, amongst others, relies upon the sixth respondent's Communication to contend *[i]* that the seventh respondent operates *a Commercial Kitchen* with noise levels above the permitted noise levels in a residential layout, *[ii]* that the seventh respondent has also got another kitchen in the said vacant area, *[iii]* that despite the Pollution Control Board's Report and repeated representations, no action has been taken.

Sri Pawan Kumar, a learned standing counsel for the respondent Nos.1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, is called upon to accept notice for these respondents deferring orders on the petitioner's request for an interim arrangement for the present. Sri Mahesh Chaudhary, a learned standing counsel

for the sixth respondent, is called upon to accept notice for this respondent.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall ensure that the copies of the petition papers are served on the respective Chambers at the earliest. The third respondent is called upon to file into this Court in writing the details of the action that is taken under the Pollution Control Board's Report dated 22.06.2022 as per Annexure-F.

There shall be Notice by hand returnable by **17.07.2026** to the seventh and eighth respondents.
