ORAL ORDER

Sri M A Subramani, the learned counsel who has filed *vakalath* for the fourth respondent, is permitted to correct the Presentation form during the course of the day to comply with the office objections. Further, Sri M A Subramani places on record the following. **[a]** The road that the petitioner refers to in the petition has been widened decades back, **[b]** that M/s. KRIDL is entrusted with development of this road requiring any additional extent on either side of the road, **[c]** that M/s. KRIDL has also completed a substantial part of asphaltting/blacktopping this road, and **[d]** that M/s. KRIDL is only in the midst of completing the finishing work. The learned counsel is categorical in stating that the petitioner's apprehension that some additional extent of land is now utilized is completely misleading.
