ORAL ORDER

Sri Chandrakanth R Goulay, the learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that this Court must grant an interim order restraining the fifth respondent from putting up the construction because the construction is contrary to the *Sanction Plan* and the Authorities are not taking any action. When queried, the learned counsel submits that the petitioners' grievance is independent of the dispute pending before this Court in a second appeal.

Sri A Ravishankar, a learned standing counsel for both the third and fourth respondents, is called upon to accept notice for these respondents and secure instructions in the light of the afore.

Sri Bopanna Belliappa, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the first and second respondents.

There shall be Notice by hand to the fifth respondent returnable by the next date of hearing.

Sri Chandrakanth R Goulay is reserved with liberty to seek interim orders on the next date of hearing.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **17.07.2026** as part of ***'Third List'***.
