ORAL ORDER

This Court's previous order dated 09.07.2026 is perused. Sri Chandrakanth R. Goulay, the learned counsel for the petitioner, places on record photographs of the construction by the fifth respondent stating that the fifth respondent is served with the notice by hand as directed. The learned counsel will also have to ensure that the affidavit of the person who has effected the service of notice by hand is filed. The learned counsel is reserved with liberty in this regard, and the needful shall be done by the next date of hearing. The fifth respondent is absent despite having been served.

The photographs of the construction complained as of now read as under:



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On behalf of Sri A. Ravishankar, the learned counsel for the authorities [the third and fourth respondents], it is stated that instructions are still awaited. The principal assertion against the construction by the fifth respondent is that it is without a setback and encroaching some portion of the petitioner's land.

In view of the afore, to ensure that there is no precipitation, the interim order is granted stopping all further construction without the leave of this Court.



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The third and fourth respondents are called upon to ensure that the construction is stopped, and if necessary, they shall avail the assistance of the jurisdictional police to see that the construction is stopped.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **21.09.2026.**
