ORAL ORDER

1. The submission of Sri.S.Rajashekar., learned counsel for respondent No.3 is that though elections have not been held by a majority of the members of the Advocate's Clerks Association, the office bearers have been chosen. The concept of majority would only apply in the electoral process by complying with all the trappings of election process. It cannot, without holding elections, be contented that the majority has selected/elected the Office Bearers.
2. Faced with the above situation, Sri.S.Rajashekar., learned counsel for respondent No.3 seeks for and is granted ten days' time to make his submission as to when the elections would be held. Since, if no such submission is made, the District Registrar would have to be directed to conduct necessary elections by appointment of an Administrator, after enrolling members across the State.
3. Re-list on **20.07.2026**.
4. Interim order granted earlier is extended till the next date of hearing
