ORAL ORDER

1. Learned counsel for respondent No.5 submits that insofar as prayer No.E is concerned, it is a PDO who is a necessary party.
2. Since he has not been made a party to these proceedings, the above petition would not be maintainable insofar as prayer No.E is concerned. His submission is placed on record.
3. Learned Additional Government Advocate submits that Co-ordinate Benches are seized of other similar matters. A list thereof has been provided to the counsel for the petitioner, who seeks for ten days' time to verify and make his submissions.

4. Since Co-ordinate Benches have seized similar matters, this matter would also have to be heard by the Co-ordinate Benches.
