THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PRAYING TO A. DECLARE THAT THE MSMED ACT IN SO FAR AS IT HAS NOT CREATED A SPECIAL FORUM/TRIBUNAL TO ENFORCE THE INTER-SE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS/REMEDIES, WHICH IT HAS CREATED IN ADDITION TO THOSE RIGHTS/OBLIGATIONS/REMEDIES RECOGNIZED BY THE COMMON LAW, THE JURISDICTION OF THE CIVIL COURT IS NOT OUSTED, FOR IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OUST THE JURISDICTION OF THE CIVIL COURT WITHOUT PROVIDING FOR AN ALTERNATIVE FORUM/TRIBUNAL TO ADJUDICATE THE INTER SE DISPUTES BETWEEN PARTIES WHO ARE GOVERNED BY THE ACT, AND FURTHER AS A COROLLARY THEREOF, THE DRTS, NCLTS CREATED UNDER THE RDB ACT 1993 AND THE COMPANIES ACT 2013 ARE INVESTED OF NO JURISDICTION TO ADJUDICATE A DISPUTE ARISING OUT OF/INVOLVING THE MSMED ACT, AND ETC.,
