ORAL ORDER

Learned High Court Government Pleader takes notice for respondents No.1 to 3. Notice to other respondent is not necessary for the following reasons:

Learned High Court Government Pleader raises preliminary objection that the order impugned is passed by the Assistant Commissioner, Ramanagara Sub-Division, Ramanagara, under Section 136(2) of the Karnataka Land Revenue Act, 1964, and such an order is revisable before the Deputy Commissioner under Section 136(3) of the Act.

2. Upholding the submissions of the learned High Court Government Pleader, the writ petition stands ***disposed of*** reserving liberty to the petitioners to approach the Deputy Commissioner to redress their grievances.
