ORAL ORDER

Sri Francis Xavier, the learned counsel for the second respondent, submits inviting this Court's attention to the emails addressed by the first respondent, that the first respondent has called upon the bank to mark lien for a sum of Rs.15,73,864/- but the outstanding is only about Rs.6,44,915/- and as such, the petitioner has not been permitted to operate the account.

Sri Basanna Gowda, the learned counsel for the petitioner, proposes to elaborate on why the first respondent could not have marked any amount but that has to be examined only when Smt. Saritha Kulkarni, the learned Additional Government Advocate, is securing instructions on the circumstances in which the first respondent has called for marking lien.

Hence, the office is directed to re-list this petition on **25.03.2026** and by then the first respondent shall file a report on the reasons for asking for marking of lien.
