ORAL ORDER

Mr. Narayan Swamy, the learned counsel who appears for the petitioners, submits that the petitioners' cause, which is not accepted by the Tribunal, is essentially against the official respondents but to bolster the petitioners' case that the State Government has admitted of past service to the similarly placed persons [*the private respondents*], they are arrayed as the respondents but the petitioners do not have any cause against them.

In the light of these submissions, the notice to the fifth to ninth respondents stands dispensed with.

Mr. Vikas Rojipura, the learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to secure instructions for disposal

of the petition in the light of the petitioners' essential grievance that the petitioners' permanent appointment with the fourth respondent is in the public interest and therefore, they cannot be denied the benefit of their past service.

The office is directed to re-list this petition on **19.12.2025.**
