ORAL ORDER

Sri H. Ashok Kumar, the learned counsel for the petitioner, relying upon the interim order granted by this Court on 02.12.2025 in W.P.No.34063/2025, submits that in very similar circumstance this Court has called upon the learned Additional Government Advocate to secure and file relevant extracts of the affidavit filed by the State before the Apex Court to justify the claim that such land must be deemed to be a Forest and that this Court has restrained the respondents from dispossessing the concerned until such affidavit is filed.

For reasons of parity, the interim order is granted directing the respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the subject land but stipulating that the petitioner shall not put up any permanent structures in the property

or change the nature of the property without the leave of this Court.

Sri B. Ravindranath, a learned Additional Government Advocate, is called upon to accept notice for the respondents and the office is directed to tag this petition along with the petition in W.P.No.34063/2025 on **10.04.2026**.
