THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO A) ISSUE WRIT IN THE NATURE MANDAMUS DIRECTING RESPONDENT TO CALL FOR TENDER IN RESPECT OF PROPERTY I.E., "PUBLIC TOILET BLOCK H-37, CONSTRUCTED AT GLR SY.NO.324/1 SITUATED AT BELAGAVI. CONSISTING OF 8 PUBLIC TOILET AND 3 BATHROOMS IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE AND EQUITY. B) ISSUE SUCH OTHER SUITABLE ORDER/S OR DIRECTIONS AS THIS HON'BLE COURT DEEMS FIT AND PROPER IN THE NATURE OF CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CASE, IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE AND EQUITY.

ORAL ORDER

The present writ petition is filed seeking the following prayer:

"PRAYER

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Petitioner humbly prays that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to:-

A) Issue Writ in the nature mandamus directing Respondent to call for tender in respect of property i.e., "Public toilet block H-37, constructed at GLR Sy No. 324/1 situated at Belagavi. Consisting of 8 public toilet and 3 Bathrooms in the interest of justice and equity.

B) Issue such other suitable order/s or directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the nature and circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice and equity."

2. The prayer as sought for by the petitioner is not maintainable and this Court exercising the jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India cannot issue a mandamus directing the respondent to call for a tender in respect of the



property. In that view of the matter, this Court is passing the following:

- i. Accordingly, the writ petition is ***dismissed***.
- ii. All I.As. in this petition shall stand closed.
