ORAL ORDER

The present writ petition is filed seeking the following prayer:

"a) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Hon'ble Court of the Senior Civil Judge and JMFC, at: Bilagi to expeditiously dispose of the Compromise petition filed Under Order 23, Rule, 3 of CPC, 1908 dated 15/05/2024 filed in O.S. No.21/2022 as ANNEXURE-C & disposed in accordance with law, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

b) Pass such other or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice and equity."

2. It is submitted that a compromise petition that is filed in the year 2024 is not considered till now. This Court has called for a report from the concerned Court. It is stated that due to various reasons the same could not be considered. In fact, on the last couple of occasions the parties have sought for time. However, considering the fact that the application is of the year 2024, this Court is passing the following:

ORDER

- (i) Accordingly, the writ petition is ***disposed of.***
- (ii) The Trial Court is directed to consider the application and dispose of the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.
